The Mobile County Health Department is soliciting sealed bids for Four (4) Standby Emergency Backup Generators. Two (2) at our Southwest Family Health Clinic/Dental Clinic. Two (2) at our Citronelle Family Health/Dental Clinic. Bidders will perform their own on-site inspections at both locations. Arrangements for access to clinics can be made by calling Mike Seback Manager, Project Management and Facilities at (251) 581-4210 between 7:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. weekdays.

Sealed bids will be accepted no later than Monday, May 20, 2019 at 4:00 P.M. The sealed bids will be publicly opened and read on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 at 2:30 P.M. in the Library, Room 349 of the Keeler Memorial Building 251 North Bayou Street. Sealed bids must bear the words **“Sealed Bid (4) Standby Emergency Backup Generators #2019-02”**, the bid envelope must contain the bid on an official bid form, W-9 form, Beason-Hammond Affidavit, Certificate of Insurance, Business License, and Alabama vendor disclosure statement. Sealed bids must be submitted to David McGill, Mobile County Health Department, 251 N. Bayou Street, Room 107, Mobile, AL 36603.

There will be a pre-bid meeting on Wednesday, May 08, 2019, at 2:30 P.M. in the Library, Room 349 of the Keeler Memorial Building 251 North Bayou Street, Mobile, AL 36603.

Contractors bidding on this project must be **licensed, bonded and insured. All documentation will be required to be attached to the bid.** Contractors must have insurance coverage of no less than **\$1,000,000 (One Million Dollars and no/100)**. The successful bidder will be required to have a Performance Bond in the amount of the contract and must be payable to the Mobile County Health Department. The successful bidder will provide all necessary labor, materials and expenses.
