To All Bidders:

The Mobile County Health Department (MCHD) is currently soliciting sealed bids to purchase 1 Mobile Medical Travel Trailer with the option to purchase up to 3. The sealed bid project number is **#2021-05 Mobile Medical Travel Trailer**. This Project will utilize 100 percent of Federal Grant Funds. The Project budget is \$250,000.00.

Bidders eligible to bid must not be on the U.S. General Services Administration list of Parties Excluded from Federal Procurement or Non-Procurement Programs. Bids will be submitted for a fully completed Mobile Medical Travel Trailer delivered to Mobile County Health Department. Sealed bids will be accepted until 4:00 PM, Wednesday May 5, 2021. Bid opening will occur Thursday May 6, 2021 at 2:30 PM in Library Room, Room 350, 3rd floor of the Keeler Memorial Building, 251 North Bayou Street, Mobile, AL. Sealed bids must bear the wording **#2021-05 Mobile Medical Travel Trailer**.

A Bid Bond or certified check equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid payable to the Mobile County Health Department must accompany each bid. A Performance Bond will be required as follows: 100% of the contract amount. The Performance Bond must be payable to the Mobile County Health Department and received no later than 10 days of signing the contract.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope on the official bid form, along with the State of Alabama Vendor Disclosure Statement, W-9, Beason-Hammond Affidavit, Certification of Insurance Liability and any other required information. The front of the sealed envelope shall be clearly marked with **Sealed Bid #2021-05 Mobile Medical Travel Trailer**. 1 hard copy and 1 thumb drive with specs and layout of medical trailer must be submitted in each sealed bid.

Sealed Bids must be submitted to Mr. David McGill, Manager Purchasing & Contractual Services. Mobile County Health Department, Room 107, 251 North Bayou Street, Mobile, AL 36603. Allow time for delivery and receipt prior to the bid date and time.
